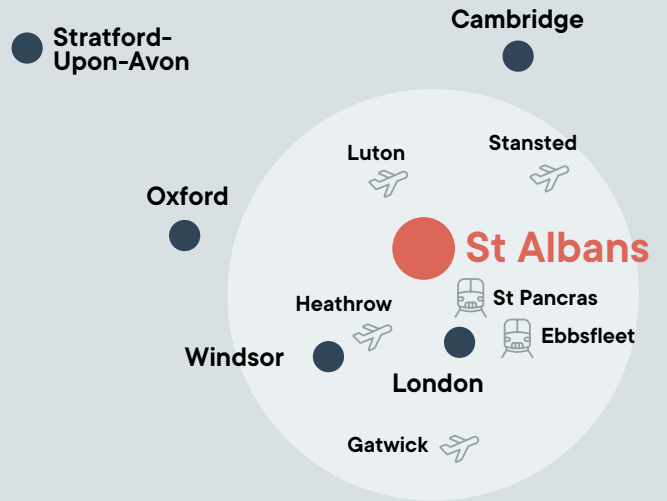

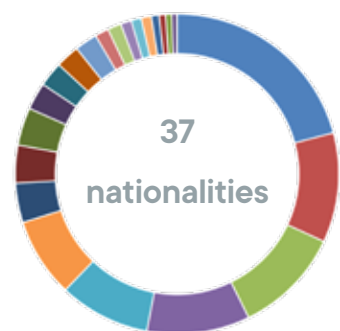

## Bedrooms

All bedrooms contain bunk beds and can accommodate between one and six students. Every room also has a wardrobe, chest of drawers and chair. **Please note:** towels and hair dryers are not provided.

## Bathrooms

Shared showers and toilet facilities, which are situated at strategic points throughout the accommodation.

## Housekeeping

Bedrooms and bathrooms are cleaned regularly. Fresh bed linen is provided biweekly.

## Meals

Full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner are served at the school and a packed lunch is provided on study tours). As well as a variety of international dishes, students will experience traditional British meals such as roast dinners and fish and chips.

## Laundry

Free laundry service for machine washable clothes once a week. Bell cannot take responsibility for any items lost or damaged during the laundry process.

## Pocket Money

£150 - £200 per week (recommendation).

## Electricity

220-240V, 50Hz AC. UK-type 3-pin plugs are used.

## Curfew

Lights are switched off between 22:30 and 23:00. Students are not allowed outside the school site without supervision.



## Supervision

- ✔ School team available 24 hours a day, all week
- ✔ Houseparents responsible for student welfare
- ✔ Houseparents available for support and advice at any time
- ✔ Staff:Student ratio is at least 1:6
- ✔ All onsite staff are police checked

  - ✔ St Albans school is 10-min drive from Radlett train station - providing fast links to London

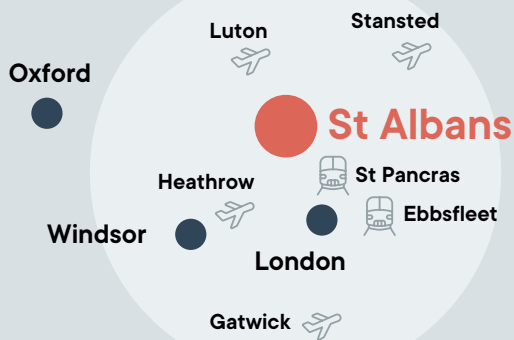

## By car from London

At junction 22 of the M25, take the A1081 exit to St.Albans. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Bell Lane/B556. Drive for 0.9 miles, and go through 1 roundabout. At the 2nd roundabout, take the 3rd exit on to Shenley Lane/B5378. Bell St. Albans is signposted and is on your left hand side.

## By train

Bell St. Albans is easily accessible by train. The closest stations are How Wood (services to/from London Euston) and Radlett (services to/from London St. Pancras). Both stations are a short taxi ride away from Bell St. Albans.

## By car from the North




At junction 3 of the A1(M), take the A414 exit to St. Albans/Welham Green. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit on to the North Orbital Road/A414. Continue for 2.5 miles. Turn left on to White Horse Lane, then continue for 0.8 miles.

At the roundabout, take the first exit on to the High Street. Continue for 0.2 miles, then turn right on to St. Anne's Road. Continue for 0.4 miles, then turn left on to Shenley Lane/B5378.

Continue for 0.4 miles until you see Bell St. Albans on your right hand side.
