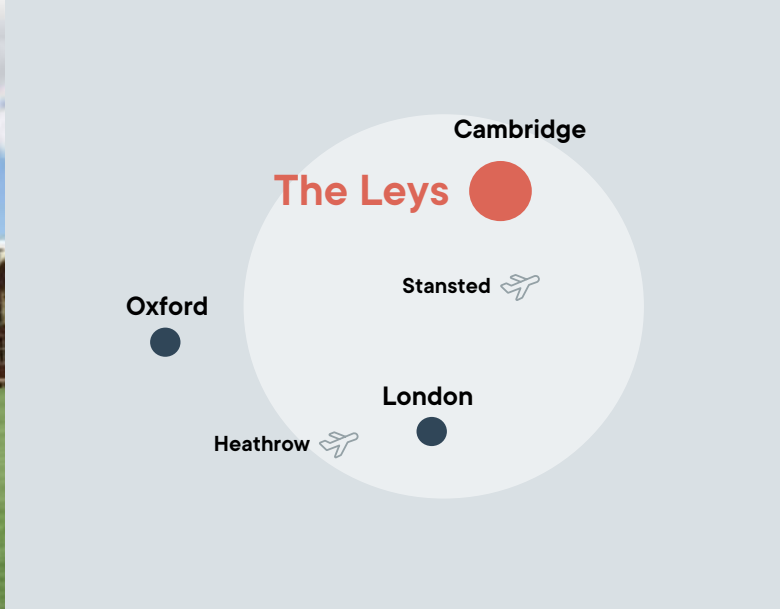

- A dedicated houseparent in every boarding house

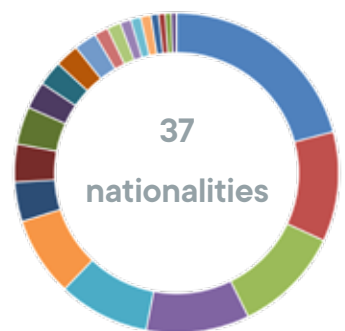
Facilities

Bedrooms

The majority of rooms are single rooms. There are a limited number of twin, triple and dormitory rooms available. Every room has a bed, wardrobe, chest of drawers and chair. **Please note:** towels and hair dryers are not provided.

Bathrooms

Shared showers and toilet facilities, which are situated at strategic points throughout the accommodation.

Housekeeping

Bedrooms and bathrooms are cleaned regularly. Fresh bed linen is provided weekly.

Meals

Full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner are served at the school and a packed lunch is provided on study tours). As well as a variety of global cuisines, students will experience traditional British meals such as roast dinners and fish and chips.

Laundry

Free laundry service for machine washable clothes once a week. Bell can not take responsibility for any items lost or damaged during the laundry process.

Pocket Money

£150-200 per week (recommendation).

Electricity

220-240V, 50Hz AC.

UK-type 3-pin plugs are used.

Curfew

Lights are switched off between 22:30 and 23:00. Students are not allowed outside the school site without supervision.



Supervision

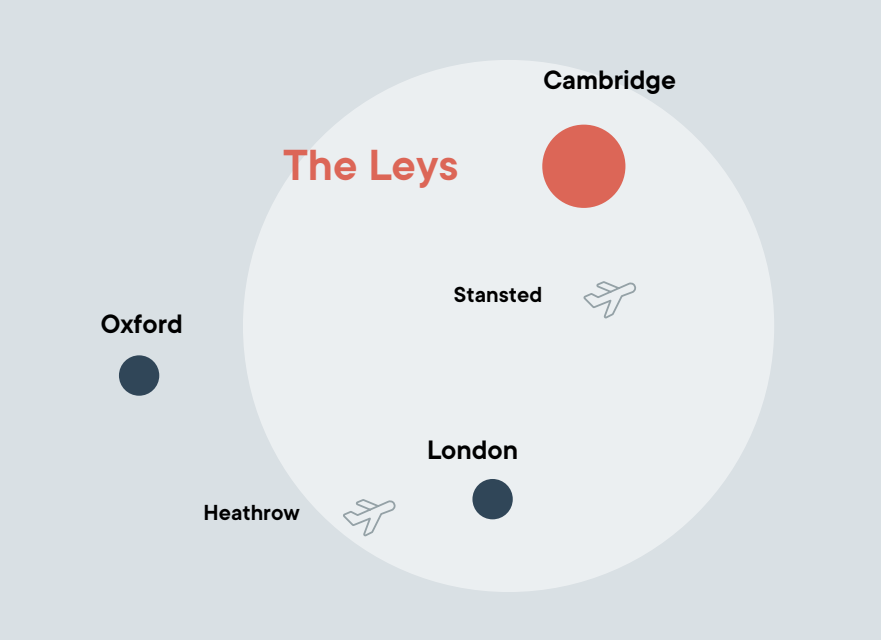
- ✓ School team available 24 hours a day, all week

Travel

From the North, Midlands and East

Exit the M11 (via A14) at junction 12. Follow Barton Road to the roundabout and turn right into Fen Causeway. The Fen Causeway entrance is on your right, shortly after the bridge.

From the South



Exit the M11 at junction 11 and follow Trumpington Road into Cambridge, continue past the Botanical Gardens, you will see The Leys campus on the left. The Trumpington Road entrance is just before the mini roundabout.

From the North East

Continue along Station Road, turn right onto Hills Road. Turn left onto Bateman Street, at the end turn right onto Trumpington Street. The Trumpington Road entrance is just before the mini roundabout.
