Banbury

Bedrooms

The majority of rooms are single rooms. There are a limited number of twin, triple and dormitory rooms available. Every room has a bed, wardrobe, chest of drawers and chair. **Please note: towels and hair dryers are not provided.**

Bathrooms

Shared showers and toilet facilities, which are situated at strategic points throughout the accommodation.

Housekeeping

Bedrooms are cleaned weekly, with fresh bed linen also provided weekly.

Meals

Full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner are served at the school and a packed lunch is provided on study tours). As well as a variety of global cuisines, students will experience traditional British meals such as roast dinners and fish and chips.

Laundry

Free laundry service for machine washable clothes once a week. Bell can not take responsibility for any items lost or damaged during the laundry process.

Pocket Money

£150-200 per week (recommendation).

Electricity

220-240V, 50Hz AC.
UK-type 3-pin plugs are used.

Curfew

Lights are switched off between 22:30 and 23:00. Students are not allowed outside the school site without supervision.







Transfers

Free transfers will be available for arrivals and departures between 7am and 7pm, depending on student travel requirements. Any students travelling as an Unaccompanied Minor are subject to an additional £60 fee (per single journey).
