Led by an experienced drama teacher, this academy will give you the chance to explore the world of theatre and film through practical activities, creative collaboration, and real-world arts and cultural experiences.



Develop a strong academic foundation for the future

Students will learn skills in acting, script writing, directing, and stage or film production. They will explore the differences between stage and screen performance, discover technical roles behind the scenes, and work together to create and perform their own scenes.

The course will finish with a talent showcase where students present their work to their peers, celebrating both their artistic and language achievements.

Full Day Excursions

Students will visit iconic theatre and film locations, including Christchurch College in Oxford for a Harry Potter-themed study tour. They will also enjoy one of the following: a backstage tour and drama workshop at Shakespeare's Globe, a West End theatre such as the Royal Albert Hall, or a trip to Stratford-Upon-Avon to explore Shakespeare's birthplace and school room.
