By the end of the programme, students will be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding in specific subject areas at Level 3 of the UK National Qualifications Framework (NQF) and will have demonstrated their learning through a range of externally moderated learning assessment methods.



The programme has the following learning intentions for students:

- To build the language, academic and subject-specific skills needed to function successfully on undergraduate degree programmes taught in English anywhere in the world
- To develop knowledge and understanding of a range of subjects as a preparation for chosen undergraduate degree programme or continued study
- To become a more independent, analytical, and reflective learner ahead of higher-level study

- Impartial support and guidance with university applications within and outside of the UK
